Automatic house points:

- Being on green at the end of the day
- Getting the green certificate at the end of the day
- Receiving a certificate at the Good News Assembly
- Being at school everyday on time in one week

Disciplinary Measures:

- A warning look.
- Quiet verbal reprimand.
- Warning card (1 min of Golden Time missed)
- Consequence card (moved position, go to hall on Fri aft to miss some of Golden time)
- Child is taken to Phase leader, who records the incident in a book.
- If this happens twice in 1 day they are sent to the Deputy or Head (White report)
- If they are taken to the Phase leader 3 times in 1 week they are then put on Yellow report.
